
CEMENT TILE AFTERCARE

CEMENT TILES MAY NEED TO BE GENTLY CLEANED ONCE A WEEK DEPENDING ON HOW FREQUENTLY THEY ARE SOILED.

DO:

- Wash your cement tile with lukewarm water on a regular basis; a soft cleaning detergent may also be used when necessary.
- Test detergent on a small area before use on the entire surface.
- When necessary, use only a soft soap or non- acidic detergent to clean your tile to remove any stains.
- Rinse your tile a few times with clean water after using a cleaning agent.

DO NOT:

- Do not use cleaning agents containing hydro-fluoric acid as hydrofluoric acid tends to damage the surface of the tiles.
- Do not use abrasive equipment to clean your tile as this will permanently damage the surface of the tiles.
- Do not use a cleaning agent that may form a film layer on the tile surface.
